

Medicaid and You

Rent:

As a resident of Cascade Park Communities you are responsible for paying rent by the 5th of each month. Every resident pays a different amount depending on their financial situation. When Medicaid is involved, this is called “Participation” or “Par” and this amount is decided by DSHS not the Community.

Par consists of your social security benefit, life insurance payouts, pensions, alimony, etc.

After rent is paid, you should be left with \$70 of personal funds, cable comes out of the \$70, NOT YOUR RENT.

Your Par acts as a deductible each month, covering the first part of the month. Medicaid pays the other part of the month.

Social Leave:

Per Medicaid, not the Community, you are allowed eighteen (18) days of social leave per calendar year. Hospital visits do not count as Social Leave. If you require more than 18 days of social leave you must ask DSHS for approval or you will be responsible for paying the daily rate privately.

Bed Hold:

When you leave for a medical reason (hospital visits, rehab etc.) the Community will hold your bed for twenty (20) days. On the 21st day you will be responsible for paying the daily rate privately until you return to the community or discharged. If you do not want to pay the daily rate you will be discharged, and your room must be cleared before your bed hold is up. Readmission will be based on availability.
